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I. Programme's Mission & Objectives

(i) Mission:

In our country, we have a large number of teachers and needs many more. All process of teacher recruitment, training, motivation, incentives, retention and feedback therefore have to be planned on a scale. Further the ultimate goal of teacher development should be to ensure that optimal learning takes place in the classroom. With this Nobel objective we have launched Master Arts in Education programme through Distance Mode both Open & distance Learning (ODL) and Online (OL) programme mode.

(ii) Objectives: The curriculum is designed having following objectives of M.A. Education:-

IV. Appropriateness of programme to be conducted in Open and Distance Learning mode to acquire specific skills and competence:

As the current educational system (in regular mode) couldn't provide such a huge numbers of quality teaching professionals, the Open Distance Learning mode will compensate deficiency. Further ODL mode will generate more effective teachers and researchers in remote places of India. it will cater the needs of the in-service candidate M.A., Education programme through Distance Learning mode is developed in order to give subject-specific skills including i) knowledge about philosophy& sociological bases of education, ii) essentials of educational psychology, curriculum design, contemporary issues in education, iii) inter-disciplinary knowledge like guidance and counselling, methods of educational inquiry, iv) modern concepts like value education, inclusive education teacher education, v) application part of education., preparation of tools development, to give detailed exposure theoretically and free-hands experience on practical parts of the study in order to impart skills of education to the learners. After the completion of this programme learners will be able to acquire necessary knowledge and develop positive attitude towards life and other members of society.

Thus Institution initiates to develop all materials in SLM format. Experts both internal & external to write the study material on the specific guidelines laid down by statutory body.

Review by Board of Studies: The course is meticulously reviewed by BOS. Recommendations of BOS are implemented on priority. It also checks & defines the applicability, credit hours, scheme of examination for the course.

Approval by Academic Council: Finally, the course is submitted to the Academic Council of the University for Final Approval.

Programs are offered on semester basis. A modular approach towards pursuing a long term degree Program is implemented. Academic activities are linked together to engage learner and maximize learning.

VI. Procedure for admissions, curriculum transaction, evaluation and medium of instruction:

Eligibility: The Candidate must have a Bachelor's Degree/Master's degree in any discipline/stream from a recognized Indian/Foreign University.

Examination: CDOE is an institution owned and controlled by the authority of Sambalpur University. The examination in respect of CDOE students is conducted by the Sambalpur University. All matters relating to the examinations, i.e. result mark sheet, degree etc. are dealt with the controller of the examination.

Evaluation: Though evaluations of Assignments / Seminar / class test / tutorial etc. are conducted to evaluate the students, yet the final evaluation is done through Term End Examination (weight age: 100%).

Curriculum Transaction: In them. MA Education course, we impart instructions mainly through Lecture method during the Personal Contact Programme. We also make use of smart class room. The printed study material is sent to the students by post. Efforts are afoot to provide the study material in soft copies to the learners and to provide them the facility to download the study material from the website through their respective student ID.

Medium of Instruction: The medium of instruction in MA Education is in English. The study material will be made available to the student in English language. The lectures in personal contact programme are generally delivered in English.

VII. Requirement of the laboratory support and Library Resources:

Laboratory support: There is requirement of Laboratory/practical which is specifically useful for accessing knowledge, reading materials project Report work. Library facility with resource is required for academic purpose to expose above requirement the candidates will be called to the University Education Department

One to One classes: From time to time, the Institution conducts one to one class online (OL) for students on demand basis
